In addition, computer-less "chalk-talks" for seminars or interviews are gaining popularity. For people used to working with presentation software, going computer-free can be a challenge.

Understanding how to work with just a marker and whiteboard will help you refine your message to its most essential components. In this workshop, we will provide tips for effectively communicating information in a chalk-talk and give examples of what to do and what not to do. Finally, participants will get a chance to plan and practice a brief presentation of their own, and get feedback in a friendly environment.
